? ? ? ? ? DID YOU KNOW..... ? ? ? ? ? COMMUNITY LEAGUE SKATING RINKS

It is surprising the number of Edmontonians that have lived in the city for any period of time that still think skating rinks located adjacent to community league facilities are built and operated by the City of Edmonton and believe they are entitled to use the rinks without being a community league member.

Outdoor rinks associated with community leagues are built by community league members. In addition to the money fundraised by the community, community leagues may have accessed matching grants from the City and the Province for construction of the rinks and they may use some of its City of Edmonton annual per-capita operating grant to operate and maintain the rinks.

North Millbourne Community League has two ice rinks – one shinny hockey rink and one family rink (no pucks and sticks allowed). Annually NMCL spends \$16,000 to operate and maintain the rinks. Volunteers raise the majority of these funds by working bingos and casinos.

The Executive Boards of community leagues set the policies and rules for rink use and has the right to revoke the privileges of any individuals who does not obey the or who shows unacceptable behaviour. NMCL has Rink rules posted both outside the door to the change facilities and inside the change facilities. NMCL requires all skaters have a community league membership which can be from any community league in Edmonton to use the NMCL rinks. The community league recommends for safety's sake that anyone using the skating rinks wear a helmet. During open rink hours the facilities are supervised by a rink attendant and this person's word regarding the use of the rinks and associated facilities is final.

North Millbourne's regular rink hours are Monday –Friday 5:00 to 9:00 pm, Saturday 11:00 am to 9:00 pm and Sunday 11:00 am to 6:00 pm. NMCL reserves the right to cancel public skate in order to run programs and donate practice ice time to Mill Woods minor hockey teams.

NMCL asks you not use the rinks if they are not open. It may be too warm and you could ruin the ice. As the rinks are generally cleared of snow and debris at the beginning of regular skating hours, using the rinks off hours could result in a delay in being able to use the rink during the regular hours. **The rinks are closed when the temperature is below -21°C with or without wind chill and when the temperature is above +2°C.** Please note that when the rink has been closed due to warm conditions and the ice melting, it may open later in the evening if the ice re-freezes.
