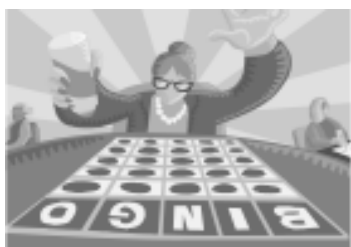

The Leisure Access Program allows eligible low-income Edmontonians to access City of Edmonton recreation facilities and programs. Cardholders receive unlimited free admissions to City of Edmonton recreation facilities and 75% off the cost of registered programs.
Edmonton residents are eligible for a Leisure Access card if they are receiving AISH, Income Support, have an Alberta Child Health Benefit card, or an Alberta Works Health Benefit card, or if their income (as shown on their Notice of Assessment) is below the Low Income Cut off line.

CIGARETTES BUTTS ARE BAD BAD BAD!!!!

THE FACTS:

- ONE IN THREE CIGARETTE BUTTS END UP AS LITTER AND BUTTS COUNT FOR CLOSE TO 50 PERCENT OF LITTER IN MANY URBAN COMMUNITIES.
- TAKES 1-12 YEARS FOR BUTTS TO BREAK DOWN BUT THEY ARE NOT BIODEGRADABLE.
- 80 PERCENT OF BUTTS END UP IN OUR WATER SYSTEMS.
- BUTTS CONTAIN ARSENIC, CADMIUM, LEAD AND OTHER CHEMICALS TOXIC TO HUMANS AND WILDLIFE ALIKE.
- OVER A 2 HOUR PERIOD VOLUNTEERS PICKED UP CLOSE TO 300 CIGARETTE BUTTS JUST AROUND THE COMMUNITY LEAGUE HALL NOT INCLUDING THOSE IN PARKING LOT THAT WERE SWEEPED UP. THESE BUTTS ACCUMULATE IN LESS THAN ONE YEAR!
- FINE IN EDMONTON FOR CIGARETTE BUTT LITTERING IS \$250 UNDER BYLAW 14614.
- BURNING BUTTS DROPPED ON THE GROUND OR OUT OF VEHICLES CAN START DISASTEROUS GRASS AND FOREST FIRES.

WHAT CAN SMOKERS DO?

- SMOKERS HAVE THE ULTIMATE POWER TO REDUCE/ELIMINATE CIGARETTE LITTER. **TAKE RESPONSIBILITY!**
- ALWAYS DISPOSE OF BUTTS RESPONSIBLY
- THINK BEFORE YOU LIGHT UP KNOW WHERE THAT BUTT WILL END UP.
- USE ASHTRAYS, PORTABLE POCKET ASHTRAYS OR PUBLIC RECEPTACLES.

WHAT CAN EVERYONE DO?

- EVEN NON-SMOKERS CAN HELP.
- TELL FRIENDS, FAMILY CO-WORKERS ABOUT THE ENVIRONMENTAL AND HEALTH PROBLEMS CAUSED BY CIGARETTE BUTT POLLUTION AND ENCOURAGE THEM NOT TO LITTER.
- **DON'T BE AN OSTRICH WITH YOUR HEAD IN THE SAND – EVEN THOUGH YOU ARE NON-SMOKER, PROVIDE PUBLIC SMOKING RECEPTACLES TO HELP SMOKERS MAKE THE RIGHT DECISION. IGNORING THE PROBLEM WILL NOT MAKE IT GO AWAY – CALL IT HUMAN NATURE.**
- CLEAN UP BUTTS REGULARLY AROUND YOUR PROPERTY – BUTTS MAKE AN AREA LOOK DIRTY AND UNCARED FOR WHICH ATTRACTS OTHER LITTER.
